Mother Nature sure kept her promise and kept things interesting this past week. It snowed 3 times with below freezing temps.

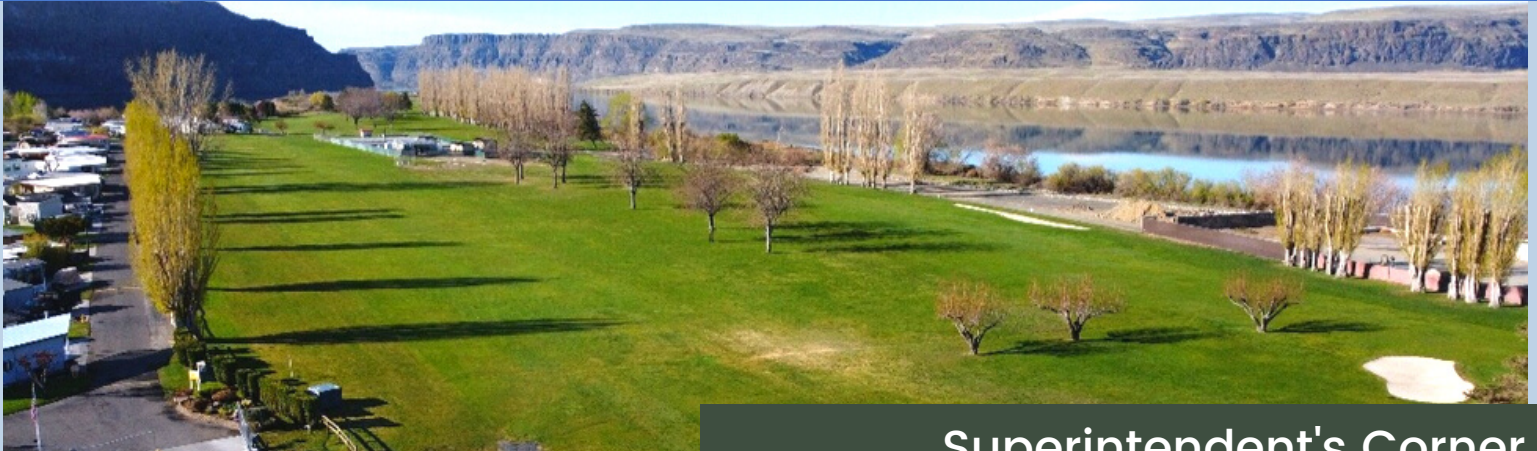
Wenatchee got the worst of it, as they received over a foot of snow and set a new snow fall for the month of April.

Superintendent's Corner

Hello Golfers,

Temperatures are back on the rise. This week has a few days that could dip down to freezing, so be sure to check in with the pro shop before playing any morning rounds. The rest of April will bring some wind and rain, but our greens are recovering beautifully, so we should start to see a pick-up in speed towards the end of the month. Just as a reminder, be sure to keep any carts (including push carts) away from the fringes of any greens.

As temperatures warm up, we become more susceptible to fungal infection. Keeping carts away from greens will help to minimize our risk of spreading fungus from the roughs and fairways to the greens. Pythium fungus is what damaged the green of #8 last year, but thankfully the green has been making a comeback. Obviously, we can never stop the spread entirely but with good practices and regular applications of fungicides I am confident that we can prevent the same thing from happening this year. Thank you and enjoy your time on the course!
