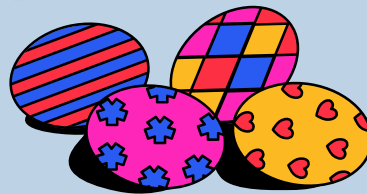

Superintendent's Corner

Hello Golfers,

April is here and the season has officially begun. Summer rates and hours are now in effect. Please refer to the website or contact the pro shop with any questions.

Over the next several days it is crucial for every golfer to follow some clear and easy etiquette on the course. This week is possibly one of the most important weeks for the golf course this entire season, from a superintendent's perspective. We will be aerating greens. Over the span of a year a golf green goes through a very delicate and fascinating process, just like any crop or vegetation. An individual turf plant is constantly working to keep itself alive, using light, air, soil nutrients, and water to achieve this. We aid in the process by providing the turf with nutrients in the form of fertilizer. We also aid in that process by removing excess organic matter that is created from the life cycle of the plants. That's what aeration is doing. We are taking out organic matter, so the plants don't suffocate in their own waste and so that they have new soil (sand) to grow into. Organic matter also holds onto excess water that can harbor fungus. In other words, this action on the greens is critical for the turf's survival and to keep it in an unnatural state for playabilities sake. Our crew and I will be putting in extra time and effort to make the process as swift as possible. Please follow any instructions given to you by the pro shop and follow any signs posted on the course. It is a golfer's responsibility to the course to do so. Etiquette is the name of the game. Without it we cannot call ourselves golfers at all. I'm very pleased with what I have seen so far and stoked to see what we can make of the course this year. Thank you!
