Superintendent's Corner

Progress has been made on servicing our irrigation system. You may notice that some of the roughs are a bit longer than usual, but we are catching up with that today and they should be playing as usual this week. The greens have received another round of nutrition and will be at a lower risk of infection now that the season is about to move into autumn. They are healthier than ever, and their condition is a sign of diligence on behalf of our stellar crew and the golfers. Thank you for all of your help in fixing ball marks and keeping carts at a distance. Green 8 is a beautiful example of what proper care from everybody at the course can do for a green. We are one year from the pythium infection and it's hard to tell that it was ever even there.

There have been some items disappearing from the course lately. A fairway yardage marker, some tee markers and even ball washer towels. Please keep any eye out for any of this activity around the course and if you see anything suspicious, please contact the pro shop right away. When areas are closed off from the public its not only for the safety of the golfer and the turf, but also for our sprinklers. When a sprinkler has the dirt around it removed it is often because we need to be able access the lower portion of the housing for testing purposes, and this puts them at risk of being broken if they are stepped on or driven over. When this happens it means that we must spend time fixing that, taking away from our other maintenance activities. Please stay out of closed off areas so that we can avoid this happening and be aware of our quick coupler sprinklers throughout the rough. I know it can feel like a maze out there with all the cones and roped off areas. We are hard at work on this course and its system, and all cooperation from golfers is seriously appreciated. Thank you and enjoy your time on the course.
