Superintendent's Corner

Thankfully we missed the smoke from the fire by the old vantage highway. It is that time of year where things can light up easily. Even driving carts through the dryer areas surrounding the course can cause a fire from the heat underneath the cart, so please be mindful of this and stick to the fairways and irrigated roughs.

The greens are looking beautiful, a bit soft but very healthy and consistent. You may notice some dark staining on areas around the roughs and fairways that have been struggling due to heat and drought stress. Many of these spots have their water issue fixed but it can be tough for them to green back up once they've hit the dormant phase. The stain is from a mix of nutrients that will help to boost the vigor in the plant and give it the energy required to bounce back and green up.

Hole 7 has been closed and unfortunately will continue to be until some work can be done on a leaking section of irrigation line. Thank you for playing around the hole and staying off the green. The ground around the green is saturated from the leak and this condition mixed with heavy traffic is the formula for disease spread. Thankfully, as mentioned before, the greens are healthy and vigorous and have shown little to no signs of disease pressure, so lets keep it up! Thank you and enjoy the course.
