## Superintendent's Corner

Summer weather has made an appearance! When temperatures swing up or down this dramatically it usually leads to wind. Tomorrow (Tuesday) we could see gusts upwards of 30 mph, so beware of downed branches, especially along the west edge of the course by the poplars. There are some dryer areas of the course that will be receiving some supplemental irrigation to keep up and stay green. Tee box 6 took a hit from the extra heat. It has since been addressed and should be greening up before long.

With the higher temperatures and extra irrigation taking place around the greens we are now at risk of pythium fungus. We are on a fungicide regiment to help deal with this possibility. Good practice by our team, and by the golfers on the course, is crucial to maintain the health of our greens. Please keep all carts off the fringes (30 ft from the green is a good rule of thumb) and repair your ball marks. Pythium will incubate in soil that is exposed so by fixing ball marks right away we minimize the opportunities for it to take hold in the first place. Thank you for your help in caring for our course and have fun!
