Hello Golfers,

The turf is greening up in dramatic fashion and this week the first mowing of fairways and greens will take place. Now that March is ending, I can say that it's one of the best March's I have ever seen in the valley. Minimal wind and warm sunny days with bits of rain equals great golfing weather. Let's hope April doesn't disappoint. First aeration of greens, is scheduled for April 5th through the 7th. This is a critical regiment for healthy greens. By removing organic matter and replacing it with fresh sand we give the greens a firmer surface and more oxygen exchange in the root zone and most importantly helps prevent fungal disease.

Please be patient with us during this process and keep off any greens that are being worked on, or that are marked "closed." With how well the greens have come out of winter they should recover in no time. Besides, The Master's will be playing the following weekend, so it'll be a good excuse to sit at home all day.
