Memorial Day was a beautiful weekend with some fun thunderstorms scattered in-between. Mother nature likes to keep up guessing for sure.

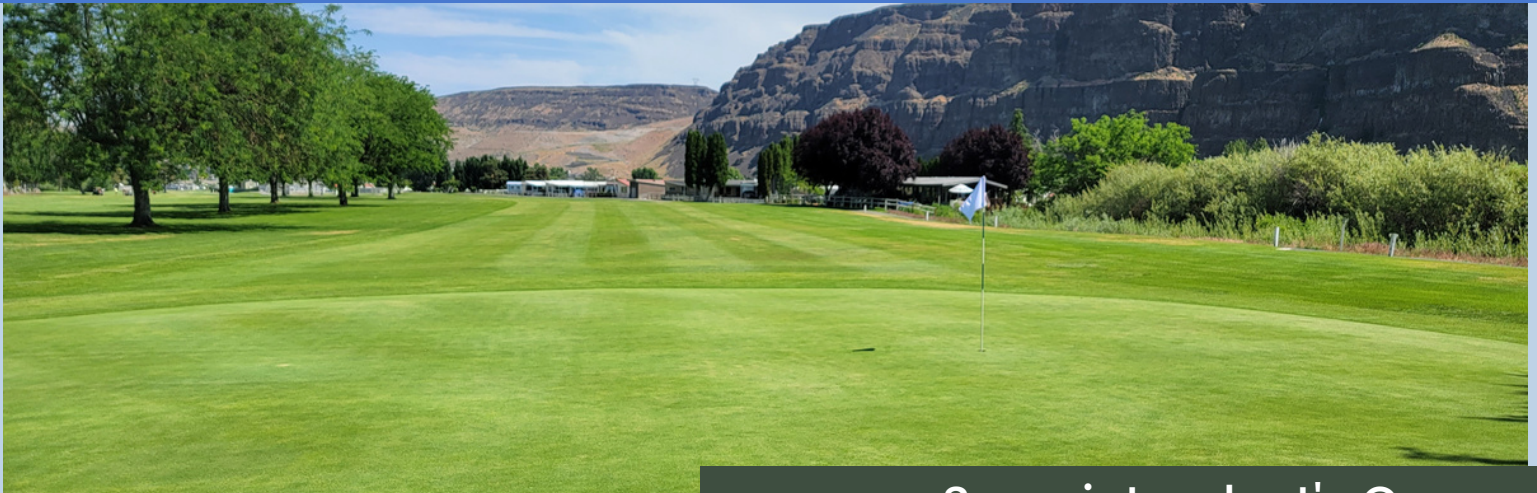
The walking trail is open and paving is done. We have a beautiful new coat of asphalt in parts of the trail. We were glad to get rid of the bumps created by the tree roots.
