Superintendent's Corner

Fall aeration is done and was a success. Some wetter areas of the greens took a hit, and some bumpy tracks were left behind but with time they will smooth over and fill in. What you're seeing on the surface doesn't do justice to what happened below the surface. The shatter tine aeration "shatters" the soil in a sense. Breaking apart bonds and old roots, allowing for accelerated exchange of nutrients and new root growth to take hold. The individual plants of greens grass live mostly below the surface with roots that stretch 4-6 inches down into the soil and grass blades that sit only 1/8 of an inch above the surface. This is obviously not the natural state of the plant, so in order to maintain the health of the greens they need amendments to the soil such as aeration, humic acid, wetting agents, growth regulators and so on.

I appreciate your patience through aeration and soon we will all reap the benefits when the greens have fully recovered. Have fun and enjoy the course!
