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Superintendent's Corner

Golfers,

Fall has officially begun and with that brings fall projects, including aeration of the greens. You will be happy to know that we plan on a "shatter-tine" aeration instead of our usual core aeration. This involves using the same machine only with solid spikes instead of hollow spikes, meaning no core will be pulled. This along with a light top dressing of sand results in a more playable greens surface immediately after the aeration process. Once our machine and sand spreader are finished with a green, it will be open for play. If all goes to plan, we will start this process tomorrow, Wednesday the 28th, and finish by the end of Thursday. When playing, be aware of our equipment and crew performing the job and please skip any green that we are currently working on. This will keep our crew safe and the pace of play running smoothly, rather than waiting for the green to open. I appreciate your patience and cooperation. The greens will receive an improvement in compaction and added oxygen exchange in the root zone from this process, which is a key element in healthy turf. Thank you and enjoy the course!
